BIOGRAPHY

Born in 1950 in the Tarn, south-west France, Annette Cunnac lives and works in Toulouse where she settled in 1983. At that time she joined evening classes in the studio of Pierre Darques at the **Fine Art School of Toulouse** where she acquired a strong grounding in drawing and painting which she continued at the **Académie de Dessin de Toulouse**.

Having jointly conducted her professional career and her passion for painting today she devotes herself entirely to her art.

In 2014 she becomes member of the **Société des Artistes Français** and since then has exhibited at the annual "Salon" des Artistes Français as part of "Art en Capital" at the Grand Palais in Paris. She regularly presents personal exhibitions and she participates in art fairs during which she has received numerous awards. For all of her work, she was rewarded in 2022 with the prestigious Renée Aspe painting prize awarded by the **Académie du Languedoc**.



Annette Cunnac draws from her immediate environment and her travels abroad. These are the inspiration for her paintings which are the fruit of direct and sensitive observations of the world around her. Her favorite themes are landscapes and scenes from life.

She works outdoors, in direct contact with the "motif" in order to capture light and colour. *"When I paint outdoors, I am in a state of total receptivity so that nothing distracts the eye from what matters"*.

Guided by shapes and colours, she makes sketches, more advanced drawings as well as snapshots that constitute the base for her work in the studio. Then begins the process of thinking and choosing the subjects that she will paint. She is constantly looking for the right tone, the delicacy of colours and the balance between graphics and coloured shapes.

The common thread of her work is the transmission of the emotion felt during the first perception and the revelation of the deep character of the subject. This opens an immediate aesthetic emotion and a dialogue with the spectator.

"To magnify the reality to express the essential and to reach emotional intensity in the painting"

"I paint what my gaze captures and what I feel at each specific moment, whether it is a landscape enhanced by a fleeting light or a colourful scene from life".

Influenced by her travels, Annette Cunnac offers a new perspective on the city of Toulouse with pastels and oils whose subjects exude a deep humanity; a unique opportunity to rediscover the shimmering urban landscapes through the scenes alongside the River Garonne, the streets or the terraces of the bars which are a lively theatre decorated with warm colours. She is also inspired by the Tarn countryside and the bricks architecture with soft light and warm ochre colours.
