

# Annette Cunnac

## BIOGRAPHY

Born in 1950 in the Tarn, south-west France, Annette Cunnac lives and works in Toulouse where she settled in 1983. At that time she joined evening classes in the studio of Pierre Darques at the **Fine Art School of Toulouse** where she acquired a strong grounding in drawing and painting which she continued at the **Académie de Dessin de Toulouse**.

Having jointly conducted her professional career and her passion for painting today she devotes herself entirely to her art.

In 2014 she becomes member of the **Société des Artistes Français** and since then has exhibited at the annual "Salon" des Artistes Français as part of "Art en Capital" at the Grand Palais in Paris. She regularly presents personal exhibitions and she participates in art fairs during which she has received numerous awards. For all of her work, she was rewarded in 2022 with the prestigious Renée Aspe painting prize awarded by the **Académie du Languedoc**. In 2023 she is appointed to the Academy as Academician Associate Member.



## PRACTICE

Annette Cunnac creates oil or acrylic paintings and pastels on paper

She draws inspiration from her immediate surroundings and from her travels, the source of her paintings, which are the fruit of a direct and sensitive observation of the world around her. She paints reality by highlighting its poetry and its colors. She reveals all the richness of a sublime universe. Her favorite themes are landscapes and scenes of life.

She works outdoors, in direct contact with the subject to capture the variations in light and color. "When I paint outdoors, I am in a state of total receptivity so that nothing distracts the eye from what is important." Guided by shapes and colors, she creates sketches, more detailed drawings, and photographs that will form a basis for her studio work. This is where the time for reflection and choosing subjects begins before moving on to the act of painting.

She constantly searches for the right tone, the delicacy of colors and a balance between graphics and colorful forms. To transmit the emotion felt during the first perception and to reveal the profound character of the subject is the common thread of her work which will open up an immediate aesthetic emotion and a dialogue with the viewer.

"To magnify the reality to express the essential and to reach emotional intensity in the painting"

Influenced by her travels, she takes a fresh look at her immediate surroundings. Her paintings capture the shimmering colors of landscapes and scenes of everyday life, such as the banks of the Garonne, or the bars of Toulouse, which are both a living and colorful theater.

She also draws inspiration from her native region in the South West of France, the Tarn countryside, revealing the soft light and warm ochre colors of its brick heritage. She develops strong contrasts between light and shadow with a vibrant palette to convey her personal vision.
